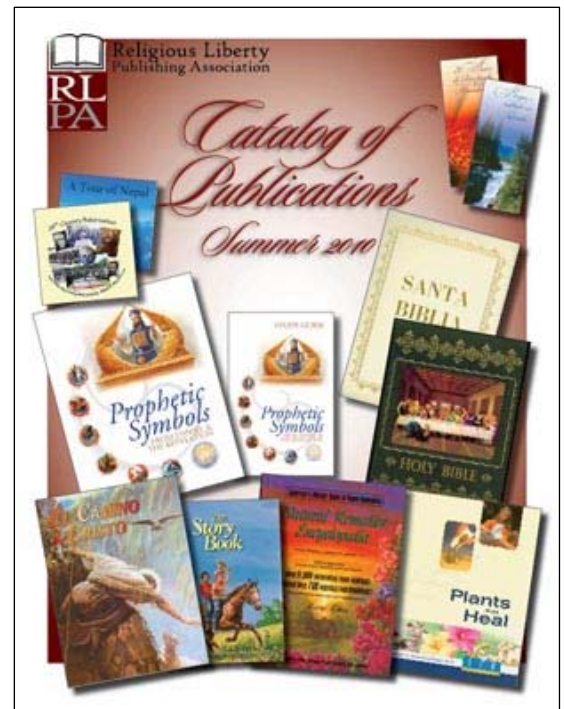

Look through the Catalog now, and order regularly for your outreach efforts!



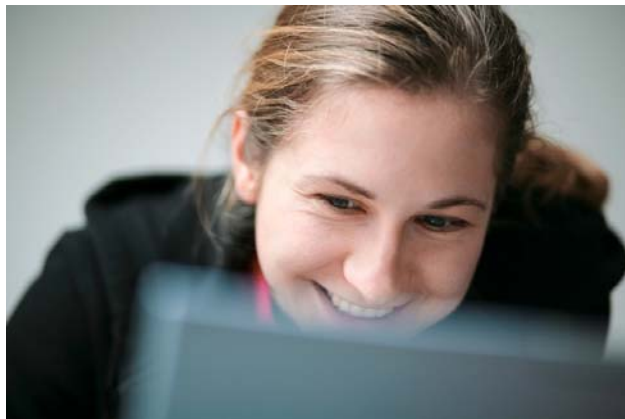
